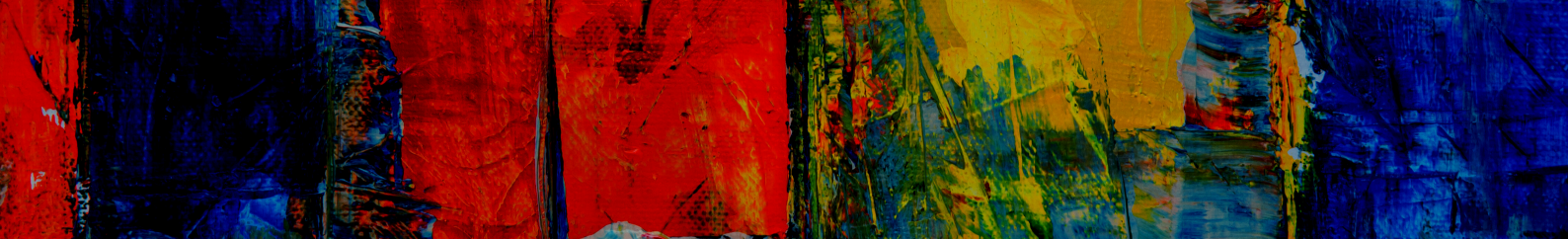

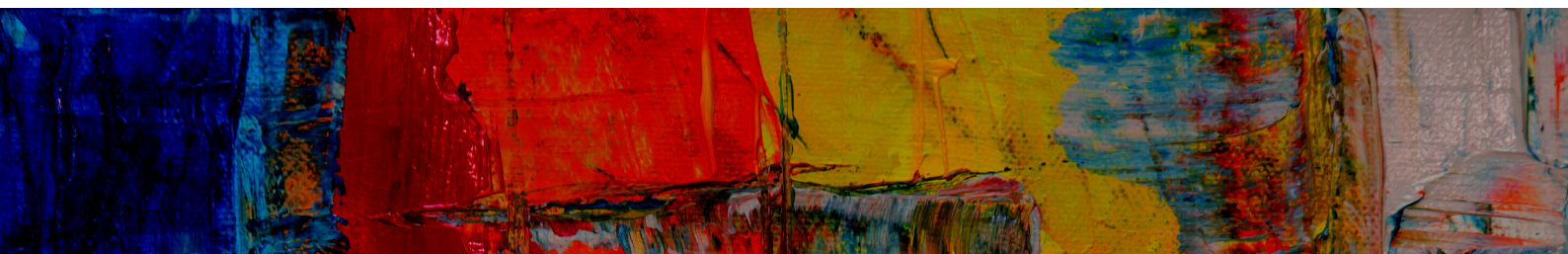
START OF THE PROJECT: February 2020

DURATION: 6 months

VENUE: Lithuanian Culture Institute (LCI)
Vilnius, Lithuania)

VOLUNTEER PROFILE: A young person (18-30 years old), regardless gender, ethnicity, social and economical background, with a strong motivation to learn and engage in creative activities and work in the field of art and culture

LCI PROFILE: The Lithuanian Culture Institute is a state budgetary institution which was founded by Ministry of Culture. A mission of the LCI is an effective and constructive representation of Lithuanian culture and arts abroad. It is also coordinating two European programmes Creative Europe and Europe for Citizens responsible for fostering open European society.





Activities for participant

COMMON ACTIVITIES:

- Visiting Lithuanian cultural organizations;
- Participating in LCI activities and events;

COMMUNICATION FIELD:

- Collecting, preparing and updating information for LCI website, Facebooks profiles, Twitter and Instagram (in English);
- Preparing information for printed materials for international projects;
- Monitoring output of the foreign media concerning LCI projects and activities;

ASSISTING IN INSTITUTE'S PROGRAMMES

IMPLEMENTATION:

- Assisting in taking care of international experts: preparing programme, meetings with local culture organizations, organizing schedule for cultural sight-seeing;
- Assisting in annual Vilnius Book Fair; helping in coordination of volunteer group;
- Assisting in tasks delegated by Europe for Citizens programme Contact Point: preparation of participant's selection, participants' evaluation and selection, preparation of materials, communication with participants, preparation and updates of information in programmes and events websites and Facebook;
- Assisting in tasks delegated by Creative Europe Desk; helping with monitoring of international cultural events funded by the programme; dissemination of activities;
- Reading and learning about Lithuanian contemporary culture and arts scene;
- Learning Lithuanian language and engaging in local cultural events.

Facilities for participant

Accommodation in a flat in Vilnius (city center or around); the volunteer would live in a shared flat in a separate room paid by the programme; volunteer will receive monthly allowance of pocket money and food money (around 240 EUR); local transportation and phone will be covered. Additional costs related to the work in the LCI will be covered by the project (visa fees, health insurance etc).



Application procedure

Young person interested in the project should send his/her CV and motivation letter to the LCI e-mail: asta@pileciamas.eu until January 17th. Selected candidates will be contacted by email and later will have a Skype call with the LCI. The selected participant will have to register in European Solidarity Corps portal.
